The food pantry sources kosher food and distributes it in a dignified manner, according to the community's needs, at no cost to recipients. After operating on an ad hoc basis for 15 years, our Kosher Food Pantry (KFP) entered an expansion phase when it moved into a permanent home in a newly renovated facility on the lower level of 77 Englewood Ave, Brighton, MA. The KFP is recognized by the Greater Boston Food Bank (GBFB) who supplies much of our food. The KFP operates in accordance with GBFB's strict standards for operations, sanitation, and food safety.
